

# SAN DIEGO CHILDREN'S DISCOVERY MUSEUM'S ACCESS FOR ALL

## Scholarship Fund



Our Scholarship Fund subsidizes educational workshops for schools on-site at the Museum or off-site through our Mobile Children's Museum (MCM). Scholarships are primarily awarded to Title-I and low-income schools, whose students receive few supplemental resources for their education, and may never visit the Museum without assistance. We continually have a wait list for schools who need assistance with both on-site workshops and Mobile Children's Museum visits.

### Field Trip School Fund

#### We provide:

- Scholarships for students from Title-I and low-income schools to take a field trip to the Museum for one of our Science, Art, or World Culture educational workshops. Scholarships subsidize price of admission and workshops for all students, in addition to transportation if needed. Workshops target preschool through Grade 3 and align with CA Common Core Curriculum, Next Generation Science Standards, Visual & Performing Arts Content Standards, and CA Preschool Learning Foundations.

#### We have served:

- Since 2010, we have provided school children field trip scholarships to the Museum.

#### We plan to serve:

- FY 2017-2018 over 12,000 school children, Preschool to Grade 3.

#### Support Needed:

- To be able to provide these services, San Diego Children's Discovery Museum is actively seeking \$140,000 of support.

### Mobile Children's Museum Scholarship Fund

#### We provide:

- Scholarships to students from low income and Title-I schools to have our Mobile Children's Museum come visit.
- Mobile Workshops are tailored for each grade level and are ideal for Preschool to Grade 3. Workshops align with CA Common Core Curriculum, Next Generation Science Standards, Visual & Performing Arts Content Standards, and CA Preschool Learning Foundations, and are based on Science, Art, and World Cultures.
- Mobile Exhibits are Museum exhibits brought out to schools and community groups.
- The Mobile Children's Museum has reached across the region as far as Chula Vista, San Diego, Oceanside, and Temecula.

#### We have served:

- Since 2015, we have brought workshops and exhibits offsite into the community with our Mobile Children's Museum.

#### We plan to serve:

- FY 2017-2018 over 10,000 school children, Preschool through Grade 5.

#### Support Needed:
